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Through TOPIO's approach citizens will gain a voice on local issues and tailored advice on critical landscape monitoring and management issues. We keep your data until the end of the project and do not share it with third parties or outside the European Union. Your data may be shared with companies we work with to support our systems.

We do not process your personal data in a way that makes automated decisions about you, and we do not create a profile of you in this way. For your personal data you can exercise the following additional rights: **access, erasure, rectification, restriction of processing**, to exercise your rights you can send your request to the contact details of the project coordinator or contact him first if you believe that your personal data and your rights are being violated.
